### An Encouraging Word

If someone asked you to describe God, what would you say? Most likely you would start by naming some of the attributes, or characteristics, of God. These attributes are important because they do not describe how God acts or what He does, but rather they describe who He is.

I have noticed that many people only tend to think about God based on a few of His attributes. Some primarily think of God as being loving, gracious, and merciful. Others think mostly about his wrath and justice. And for others, they may not think of God as a personal being, but rather as one who has infinite power and knowledge.



A. W. Tozer once said, "What comes into our minds when we think about God is the most important thing about us." If that is true, then we must do our best to fill our minds with not just some of the attributes of God, but with all of the ones that God has chosen to reveal to us in Scripture. My hope is that our study of the attributes of God today will help you to have a more complete and higher view of God. I also hope that this will not just be a theology lesson, but a time of transformation as a high view of God leads to holy living for God.
