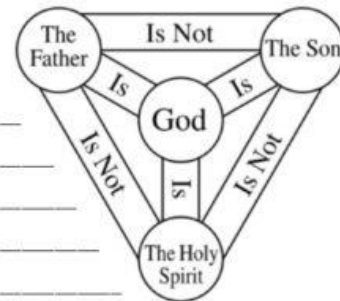
An Encouraging Word

My sermon this morning focuses on the Biblical doctrine of the trinity. Most scholars call it the "Mystery of the Trinity" because as much as we know from the Bible, it remains a mystery. The Bible teaches clearly that there is only one God. Yet the Bible also teaches that God is Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. So is God one or is God three? Therein lies the mystery of the trinity. I hope to show you from the Bible today that God is one, but God is three. He is God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit. One God in three forms. Very simply, *God is one in essence, three in person.*



Many years ago, my pastor explained it by using the analogy of an egg. An egg has three parts. The shell, the egg white, and the yolk. All three of these are different and distinct. All three of these are the egg. One egg. Three parts. The same is true with God. God is one. God is also three. God is three distinct persons. I don't fully understand it. It is beyond my ability to fully grasp. That is why we call it the "Mystery of the Trinity." But the Bible teaches it and I believe by faith in the triune God who manifests Himself as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
