**An Encouraging Word**

Most of us refer to 'church' as a place. "Where do you go to church?" "Did you go to church last Sunday?" While I don't think this is bad terminology, it does convey the idea that the Church is confined to certain locations. However, the Bible makes it clear that Church is not somewhere you go, but it is who you are. The Church is not a place, it is a people.



Today I want us to consider what it means for us as Christians to be the Church. In our individualized society, it can be easy for us to think of following Jesus only as a personal matter. Don't get me wrong; it is important for each of us to have a personal relationship with Jesus. But the Bible says that God does not want to only change us as individuals, but He wants to form us together as His people. In our passage this morning, Peter describes the unique way that God is glorified through the forming of His people into a spiritual house.

Along with considering what it means for us to be the Church, I want us to specifically think about what it means for us to be Green Valley Baptist Church. I want you to consider becoming a member if you are not already. I want you to proclaim the excellencies of God. Most of all, I want us to rejoice! Once we were not a people, but now we are God's people! All because of his mercy and grace.
