An Encouraging Word

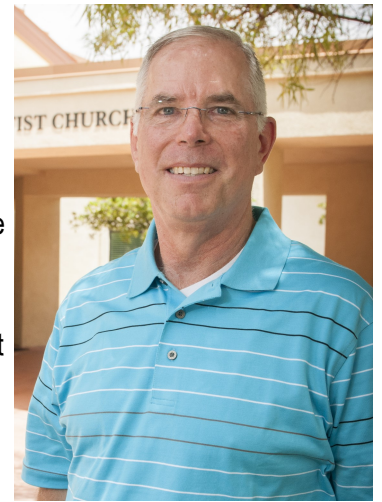
