## An Encouraging Word

In Song of Songs, the marriage relationship is likened to a vineyard or a garden. And just like a garden, for the marriage to survive it must be nurtured, cared for, and tended to on a daily basis. If you want your garden to flourish and bear fruit, you must be diligent to care for it. But there is also an ever-present danger lurking in the woods that wants to destroy your garden.

Solomon describes them as *little foxes*. These are the creatures that slowly eat at the roots of your marriage and you don't even notice them until it is too late. You look up one day and discover your garden has been destroyed and you never even knew why. Solomon's point is simply this: You need to watch out for the *little foxes* that can destroy your marriage. You need to be on your guard against all the *little things* that slowly eat away at the roots of your marriage.

In my sermon today, I will share six *little foxes* that can eat away at your marriage. As I describe these to you, my prayer is that you will make a commitment to God to rid your marriage of these *little foxes* so that your marriage can flourish and grow.
