**An Encouraging Word**

Paul asked a lot of questions in his letter to the Romans. According to my count, he asked about 76 questions throughout the entire letter, with most of those coming in the first eleven chapters. Which makes me ask, why? Was he hoping to gain some knowledge as his readers answered these questions? Actually, it appears to be just the opposite. Every time Paul asked a question he was trying to prove a point. He used questions to form his arguments.



In our passage this morning, Paul asks four very important questions. He uses these questions to explain how the Gospel is spread and how new people come to faith in Jesus. Based on what he writes in Romans 10:13-15, I think we can outline the spread of the Gospel into five basic steps:

1. God sends witnesses
2. Witnesses share the Gospel
3. Non-believers hear the Gospel
4. Non-believers believe the message of the Gospel
5. Non-believers call upon Jesus and are saved

Based on passages like Matthew 28:18-20 and Acts 1:8, I think there is no question that the first step has happened. God has called each one of us to go and share the good news of Jesus. We have been sent! But the second step of this process rests solely on our shoulders as Christians. We are the only ones who can carry out this step. This is why we witness!

I am really excited about this series on witnessing. My prayer is that you will be both encouraged and challenged as you see the call God has placed on your life and that God will use you to help bring more people into His kingdom!
