An Encouraging Word

When you think of the word "paradise," what comes to mind? Sandy beaches? Or snowy mountains? What would you do in paradise? Would you play endless rounds of golf? Or would you have your feet kicked up with a book in your hand?

In Genesis chapter 2, we get a brief glimpse into what God's creation was like before sin entered the world. We get to see what life was like in paradise. The Bible describes the growing trees, flowing rivers, and precious stones that God placed in the Garden of Eden for mankind to enjoy. Interestingly, something was "not good" in paradise, and that was the fact that man was alone.

This leads to the main point of Genesis 2. More important than seeing what paradise looked like or what kind of things Adam and Eve did, we get to see the purposes for which they were created. This chapter of the Bible reveals God's good plan for men and women before His creation was corrupted by sin.

In our study of God's Word this morning, my hope is that we will gain a better understanding of God's purposes for men, women, and marriage. The Christian view of these matters has always been countercultural, and that is certainly the case today. However, if we really want to live in His Story, then we need to understand the parts that He created us to play. Even more, I hope that we see how the Gospel empowers us to live for these purposes, offers us grace when we fail, and gives us the hope of a greater paradise to come.
