When people see a rainbow, it might bring about a variety of reactions. For those who are superstitious, they might begin looking for the pot of gold at the end of the rainbow. As Christians, we should think about the covenant that God made with Noah and all of creation. God said that the rainbow is a sign of His covenant that He will never again flood the earth.
